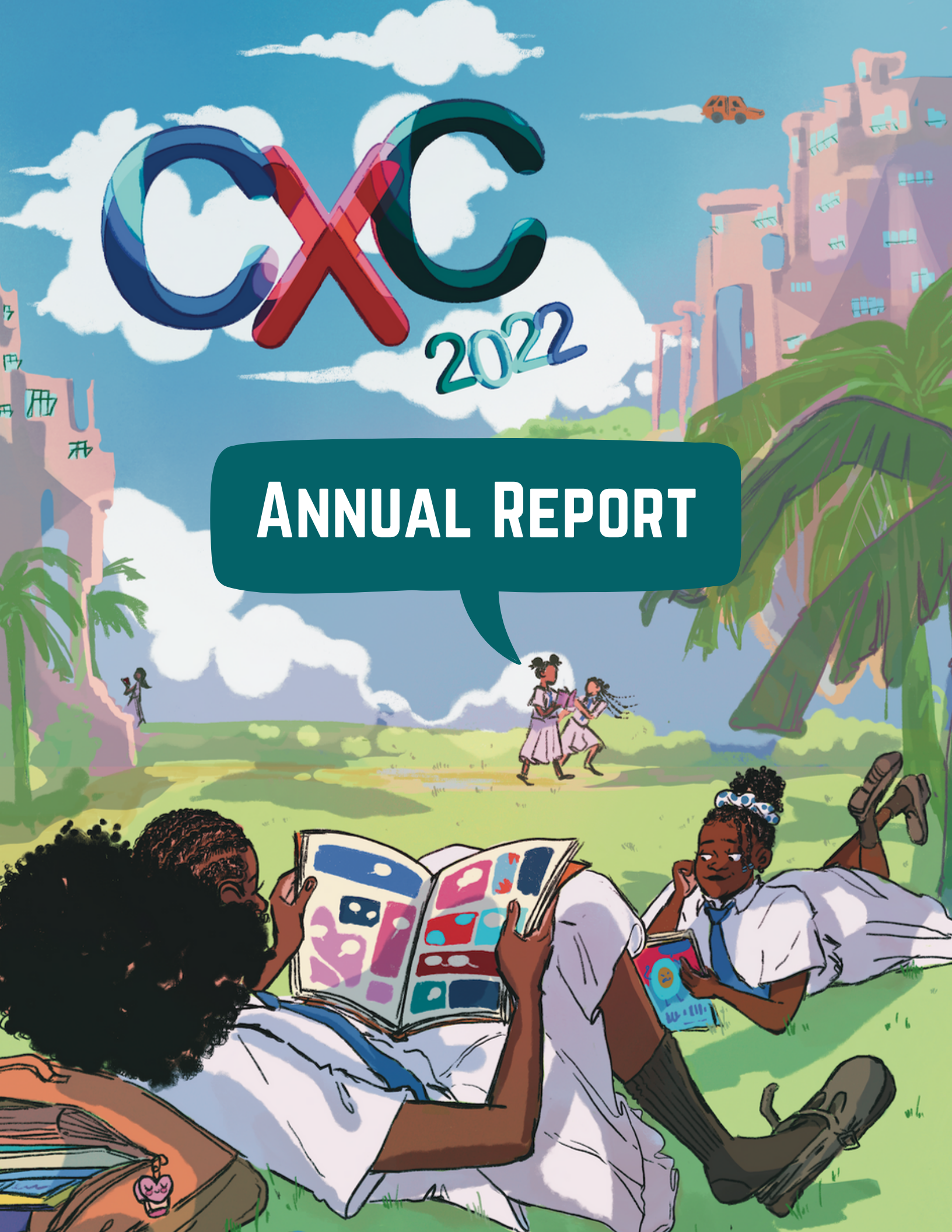

BOOK BANNING: A HOT TOPIC

This year's highlights included an queer banned books roundtable in which artists whose books have been the targets of bans talked about what that means for them and what it means for their readers. The panelists included **Maia Kobabe**, author of *Gender Queer*, **Trung Le Nguyen**, author of *The Magic Fish* and **MariNaomi**, author of the *Life on Earth* series, along with comics scholar **Dr. Rachel Miller**. At this primetime event at the *Columbus College of Art & Design*, **Kobabe** said the part of the bans that has hurt the most is the idea that many readers, especially those with lower incomes, no longer have access to the books. The authors also discussed how strange it feels that publicity about the bans has contributed to increases in sales. This was a moving session, for the panelists and the audience.

CARTOONING OF ALL KINDS

The festival celebrated many forms of cartooning, including newspaper strips, with panels featuring **Peter Gallagher**, known for his weird and fun take on *Heathcliff*, **Barbara Brandon-Croft**, the country's first Black female cartoonist to have a nationally syndicated strip, and **Steenz**, whose took over the *Heart of the City* strip in 2020 and is part of a new generation of newspaper cartoonists.

REBELS OF THE MEDIUM

Groundbreaking cartoonist and designer **Ronald Wimberly** returned to CXC this year and he was joined on a panel with cartoonist and tattoo artist **James Spooner**, moderated by **CM Campbell**, a Columbus-based cartoonist, CCAD faculty member and co-chair of CXC's programming committee. The three talked about how rebellious voices have long influenced comics and their own work, and how they see themselves in the comics landscape.

ALL GENRES, ALL AGES

CXC continued its tradition of having a robust track of programming for children and families, including a steady presence from the festival's co-founder and artistic director, **Jeff Smith**, and an array of special guests that included **Maria Scrivan**, the bestselling author of middle-grade graphic novels and a syndicated newspaper strip, breakout artist **Myisha Haynes**, author of *Anne of West Philly*, and **Ingrid Ochoa**, author webcomic *The Kiss Bet*, which has 1.5 million subscribers on Webtoon.



2022 AWARD WINNERS

Cartoon Crossroads Columbus has named the 2022 winners of awards that honor established creators and newcomers.



Keith Knight, the cartoonist behind the *K Chronicles* and *(th)ink* and the television series *Woke*, won the **Master Cartoonist Award**.

“By using humor, Keith has exposed the insecurities and hypocrisy of modern society for almost three decades now,” says CXC Artistic Director Jeff Smith, “His cartoons ring true because they are honest.”

Trina Robbins and **Lee Marrs** won the **Transformative Work Award** for their work as part of the *Wimmen's Comix* collective from the 1970s to the 1990s, and for their careers across media.

“Robbins’ and Marrs’ groundbreaking work with *Wimmen’s Comix* collective truly defines Transformative,” said Caitlin McGurk, chair of CXC’s Awards Committee and curator of comics and cartoon art at the Billy Ireland Cartoon Library & Museum. “Their efforts paved the way for femme and queer creators whose essential voices are at the forefront of the industry today.”

2022 AWARD WINNERS

Cartoon Crossroads Columbus has named the 2022 winners of awards that honor established creators and newcomers.

Victoria Douglas won the **Emerging Talent Award** for their work creating *Cinnamon*, the story of a house cat having extraordinary adventures. Douglas also runs *Halftone Hospital*, a free repository of tools for comics production.

“From the kinetic way that Victoria Douglas illustrates, to their approach to printing, they seem to represent something new and electric in the zeitgeist of comics,” said CM Campbell, a member of the Awards Committee and a cartoonist.

The emerging talent award comes with a no-strings-attached \$7,500 prize provided by Cartoon Books.

In addition to those three awards announced at the festival held Oct. 6-9, CXC’s organizers also presented the previously announced **Tom Spurgeon Award** to **Frederik L. Schott**, the writer, translator and manga scholar. The Spurgeon Award honors those who have made substantial contributions to the field of comics, but are not primarily cartoonists.

“Fred Schott’s contributions to cartoon art perfectly exemplify the example set by Tom Spurgeon for whom this award is named,” says Lucy Shelton Caswell, CXC co-founder and the founding curator of the Billy Ireland Cartoon Library & Museum. “His work expanded the world of American comics readers to include manga and its impact continues to grow.”

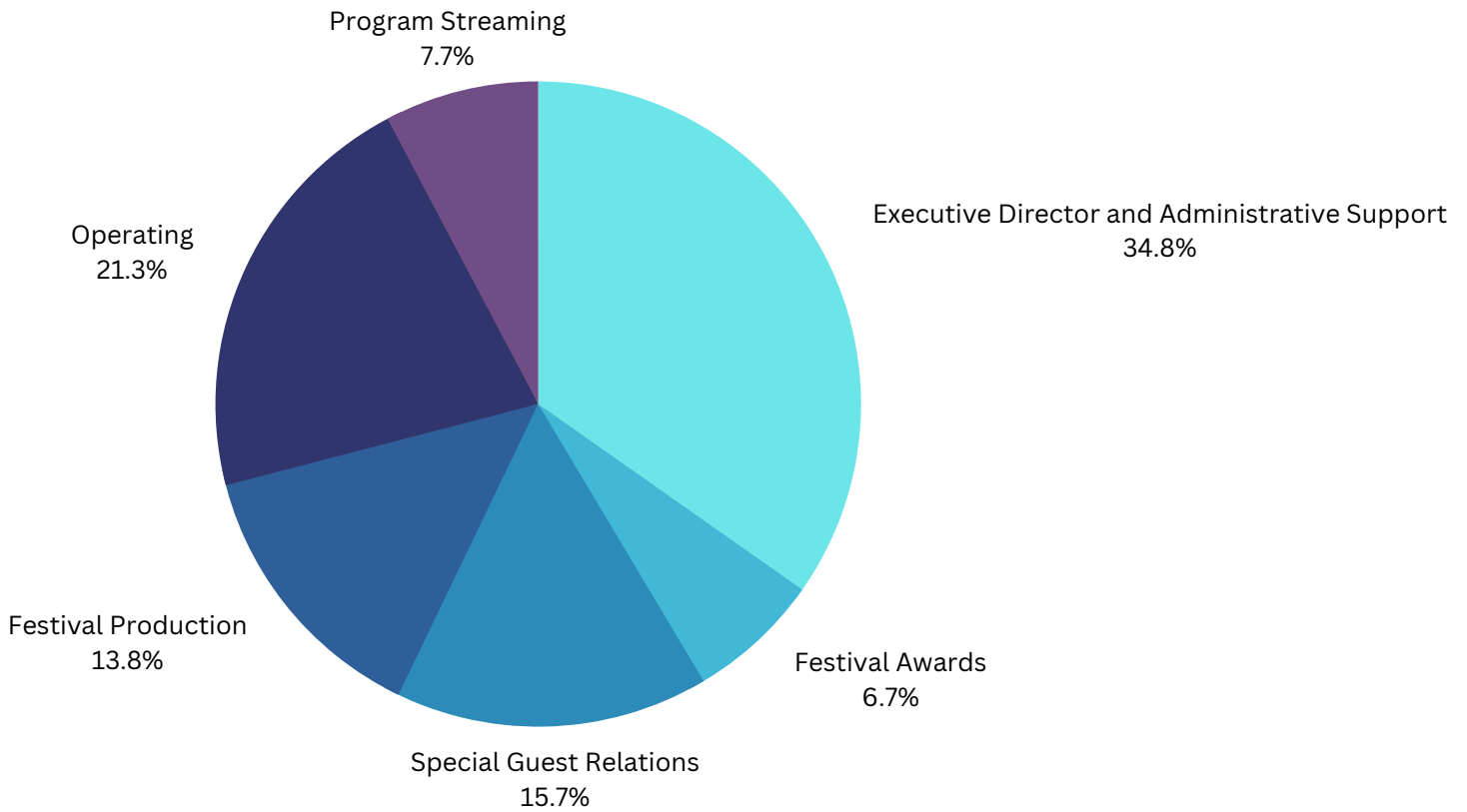
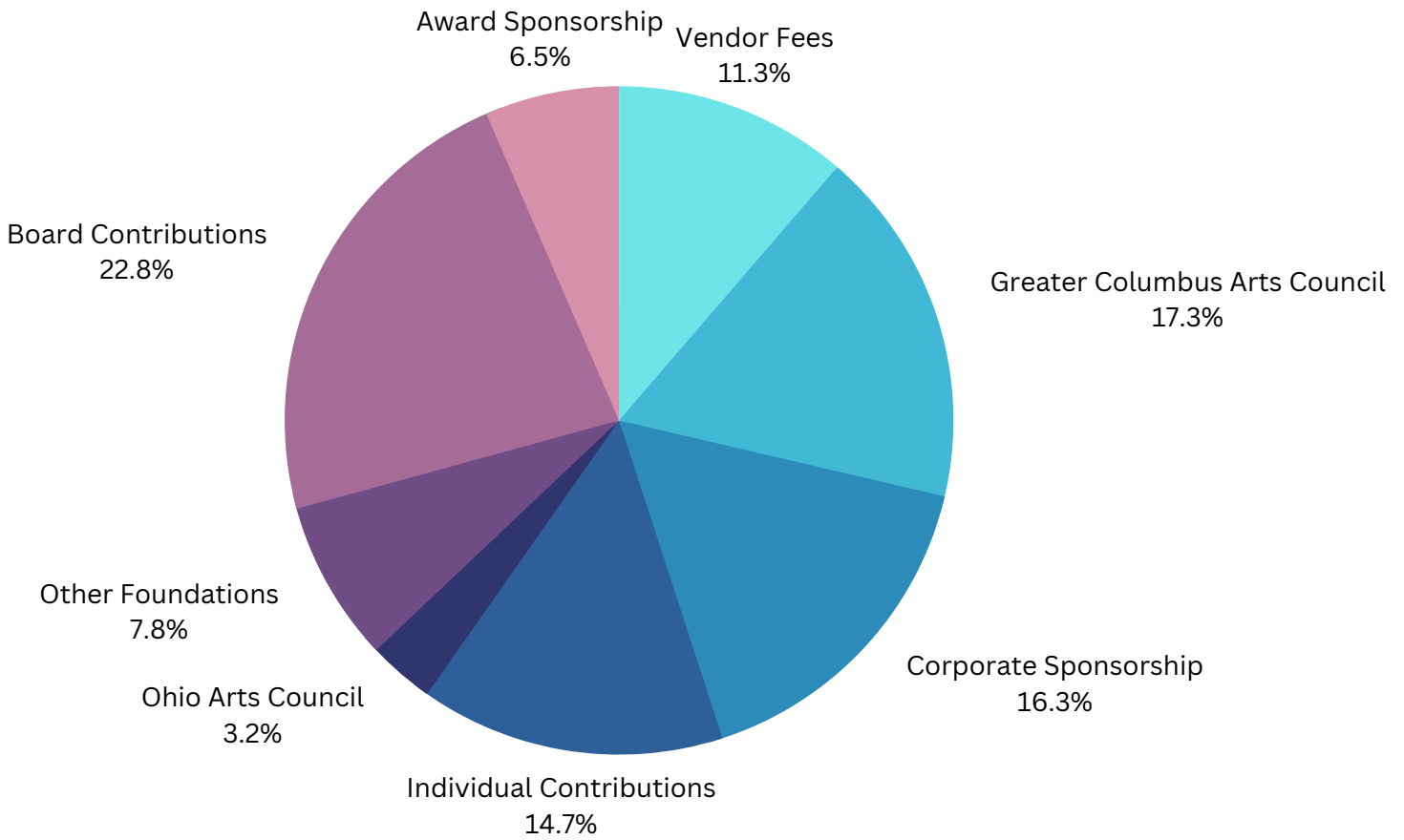
